

LITERACY

Through literacy, we will be looking at both fiction and non-fiction texts relating to space.

We will be focusing on writing single words and simple sentences using finger spaces and full stops.

We will also be recalling what we have got up to on a weekend through weekend news.

NUMERACY

In numeracy, we will be looking at practically doubling and sharing different amounts. We will use a wide range of objects and scenarios to do this.

We will also be looking at everyday language relating to time and starting to compare items based on weight.

PHONICS

Nursery children will continue looking at phase 1 sounds this term, hearing and discriminating different sounds in order. Reception will be starting to and recapping phase 3 sounds and looking at digraphs (two letters making one sound) We will be particularly focussing on segmenting and blending simple words using these sounds.
