

## Literacy

- Researching and writing fact-files about dinosaurs.

## Science

Our focus in Science will be Dinosaurs and other animals. We will identify different dinosaurs and find out which are carnivores, herbivores and omnivores. We will also identify and name a variety of common animals that are birds, fish, amphibians, reptiles, mammals and invertebrates.
