It is important to share a story with your child everyday. You should discuss the book together, encouraging your child to use the pictures to tell their own stories.

KEY WORDS

Within your child's reading packs, they will have some key words. Initially they will start with character's names and their pictures for matching. They will gradually gain more words until they have a bank of common words for sight reading.
